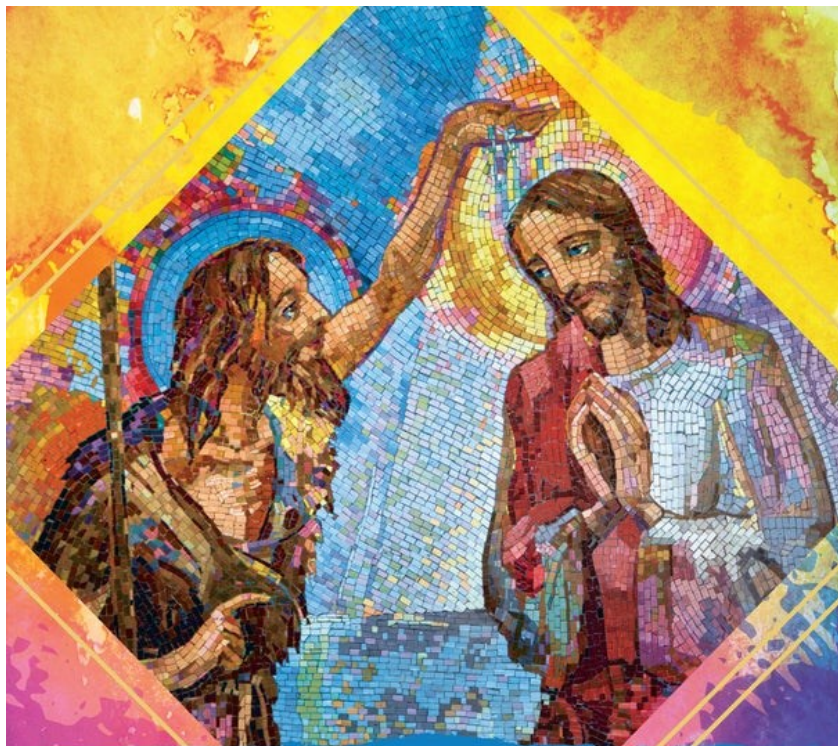

Here are this week's offerings, Tuesday January 20, which begin at 6:00pm and go for one hour sharp! Please come: you won't be disappointed!



Martha or Mary and the Confession of Faith in John 11:1-5 with Fr. Dave Beaudry

What difference does one Greek letter make? Did Martha make this profound confession of faith or Mary? This presentation will explore various documents (which you will view) such as Papyrus 66 and Codex Alexandrinus which may reveal a different narrative twist in this Johannine text.

The Story of Joseph, Son of Jacob with Dr. Paul Schweigl

This session will offer a reading of the story of Joseph from the book of Genesis, easily among the most sophisticated narratives in all of Scripture.

Queridos amigos:

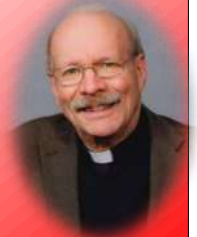

Segundo testimonio de Juan

Con toda alegría Juan nos presenta a Jesús, el Elegido de Dios.

"He aquí el Cordero de Dios que quita el pecado", ¡pero quita el pecado con la raíz y todo! Esta es la salvación de Jesús, con su amor y su mansedumbre. Al oír esto que dice Juan el Bautista, que da testimonio de Jesús como Salvador, debemos crecer en la confianza en Jesús.

Muchas veces tenemos confianza en un médico: es bueno, porque el médico está para sanarnos; tenemos confianza en una persona: los hermanos, y las hermanas están para ayudarnos. Es bueno tener esta confianza humana entre nosotros. Pero nos olvidamos de la confianza en el Señor: esta es la clave del éxito en la vida. La confianza en el Señor: encomendémonos al Señor. "Pero, Señor, mira mi vida: estoy en la oscuridad, tengo esta dificultad, tengo este pecado...", todo lo que tenemos: "Mira esto: ¡yo confío en ti!" Y esta es una apuesta que tenemos que hacer: confiar en Él y nunca decepciona. Nunca, ¡Nunca! Escuchen bien, chicos y chicas, que comienzan la vida ahora: Jesús nunca decepciona. Nunca. Este es el testimonio de Juan: Jesús, el bueno, el manso, que terminará como un cordero: asesinado. Sin gritar. Él ha venido a salvarnos, para quitar el pecado. El mío, el tuyo y el del mundo: todo, todo.» (S.S. Francisco, 19 de enero de 2014).

Juan 1, 29-34

Reflexión

En el Evangelio de hoy, se nos presenta dos tipos de bautismo: el bautismo del agua impartido por Juan y la nueva forma del bautismo que instituirá Jesucristo.

El rito del bautismo de Juan está lleno de significado. La persona que se acercaba a Juan para ser bautizada se preparaba para este momento tan importante. La entrada en el lago y la inmersión en el agua tenía el significado de dejar sumergida la vida pasada e iniciar una nueva vida. Era una muestra de conversión por la cual salía del agua dispuesto a cambiar en su forma de ser en la vida cotidiana y en su relación con Dios. El bautismo con agua será la preparación para recibir el nuevo bautismo del que habla Juan cuando Jesús fue a bautizarse, el bautismo proveniente del Espíritu Santo. Tenemos referencia de este tipo de bautismo en los Hechos de los Apóstoles cuando Pedro habla a los judíos de convertirse y hacerse bautizar por el Espíritu Santo.

El bautismo que será instituido por Jesucristo también hace referencia a una nueva vida. En este caso, a la persona bautizada se le abren las puertas a una nueva vida en el seno de la Iglesia al borrar el pecado original. Por ello pertenece al grupo de los sacramentos que hoy llamamos de Iniciación. Porque con él se inicia el camino para poder recibir todos los demás sacramentos. La práctica de bautizar por sumersión ya no se practica hoy en día, sin embargo, durante mucho tiempo se conservó en algunas iglesias un baptisterio en el cual se bajaba por una escalera a un lugar oscuro y después de ser bautizado subía de nuevo a la luz, manteniendo el simbolismo como en el bautismo del Jordán.

Propósito Recordar que en nuestro Bautizo Dios nos dijo estas palabras al hacernos sus hijos: "Este es mi hijo muy amado..." Y cada día nos acompaña como Padre bueno.

Diálogo con Cristo

Señor Jesús, para tenerte como compañero de mi vida necesito conocerte más, de manera directa, en la Eucaristía, en el Evangelio y en la oración. No quiero quedarme en la superficialidad de quienes sólo «oyen» hablar de Ti, pero no tienen una relación personal para conocer tu voluntad. Sólo en el contacto asiduo contigo se podrá formar mi corazón de discípulo y misionero de tu amor.

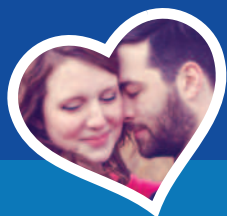
