



### Meditación del Papa Francisco

La palabra bienaventurados (felices), aparece nueve veces en esta primera gran predicación de Jesús. Es como un estribillo que nos recuerda la llamada del Señor a recorrer con Él un camino que, a pesar de todas las dificultades, conduce a la verdadera felicidad.

Todas las personas de todos los tiempos y de cualquier edad buscan la felicidad. Dios ha puesto en el corazón del hombre y de la mujer un profundo anhelo de felicidad, de plenitud. ¿No notáis que vuestros corazones están inquietos y en continua búsqueda de un bien que pueda saciar su sed de infinito?

Y así, en Cristo, queridos jóvenes, encontrarán el pleno cumplimiento de sus sueños de bondad y felicidad. Sólo Él puede satisfacer sus expectativas, muchas veces frustradas por las falsas promesas mundanas. Como dijo san Juan Pablo II: "Es Él la belleza que tanto les atrae; es Él quien les provoca con esa sed de radicalidad que no les permite dejarse llevar del conformismo; es Él quien les empuja a dejar las máscaras que falsean la vida; es Él quien les lee en el corazón las decisiones más auténticas que otros querrían sofocar. Es Jesús el que suscita en ustedes el deseo de hacer de su vida algo grande"» (S.S. Francisco, Mensaje para la Jornada Mundial de la Juventud 2015).

### Reflexión

Jesús, como en tantas otras ocasiones ha salido a predicar en descampado. Sus apóstoles y el gentío le siguen gustosos, porque saben que el Maestro tiene palabras de vida eterna. El pueblo de Israel, vagaba desconcertado por sus propios guías, los escribas, fariseos y saduceos, a quienes Jesús calificó de guías ciegos. Ahora que aparece Jesús, ¿será el Mesías? se preguntan muchos para sus adentros, pero no encuentran en Él nada de la figura de un libertador terreno, lleno de poder y castigador de sus adversarios, tan prometido por sus maestros.

Al contrario, para quienes venían buscando liberación política para Israel, topan con un Mesías que les propone el camino de la abnegación, de la humildad, de la pobreza, del sufrimiento... Pero todo esto basado en una recompensa grande en el Reino de los Cielos.

El sermón de la montaña ha resonado tantísimas veces en el corazón de los cristianos de todos los tiempos, y ha sido para todos, el mensaje de la esperanza, en medio del vaivén de las dificultades del mundo. Es la paradoja de la fe, reducida su más clara expresión: bienaventurados los que lloran, porque ellos serán consolados. Es la promesa que todos deseamos ver cumplida algún día. Pero el cristiano no es el que simplemente se resigna a todo lo que le venga. El discípulo de Cristo, empuña el arado todos los días, remueve obstáculos, limpia el terreno, trabaja, porque sabe que su esfuerzo siempre será remunerado, si no aquí, sí en la otra vida.

Por eso las bienaventuranzas no son sólo promesas para esperar, son todo un programa de vida para reformar esta tierra. Si por un día todos los hombres fuéramos pobres de espíritu, mansos de corazón, pacíficos, misericordiosos, limpios de corazón, podríamos traer el cielo a la tierra. Es cierto que el Señor permite el mal en nuestras sociedades, la desorientación y las injusticias, pero no podemos olvidar que, si lo permite, es porque está seguro de obtener de todo ello un bien mayor.

Como cristianos nos toca testimoniar este mensaje, viviéndolo en la sencillez y cotidianidad de nuestra vida profesional y familiar, dejando a Dios la posibilidad de iluminar al mundo con la luz que emane de nuestras vidas.

Dejamos la tierra que nos vio nacer para perseguir el sueño americano. Es importante que no olvidemos el sueño que Dios tiene para nosotros. Un sueño de vida plena en Él. Dios nos habla en nuestros sueños.
