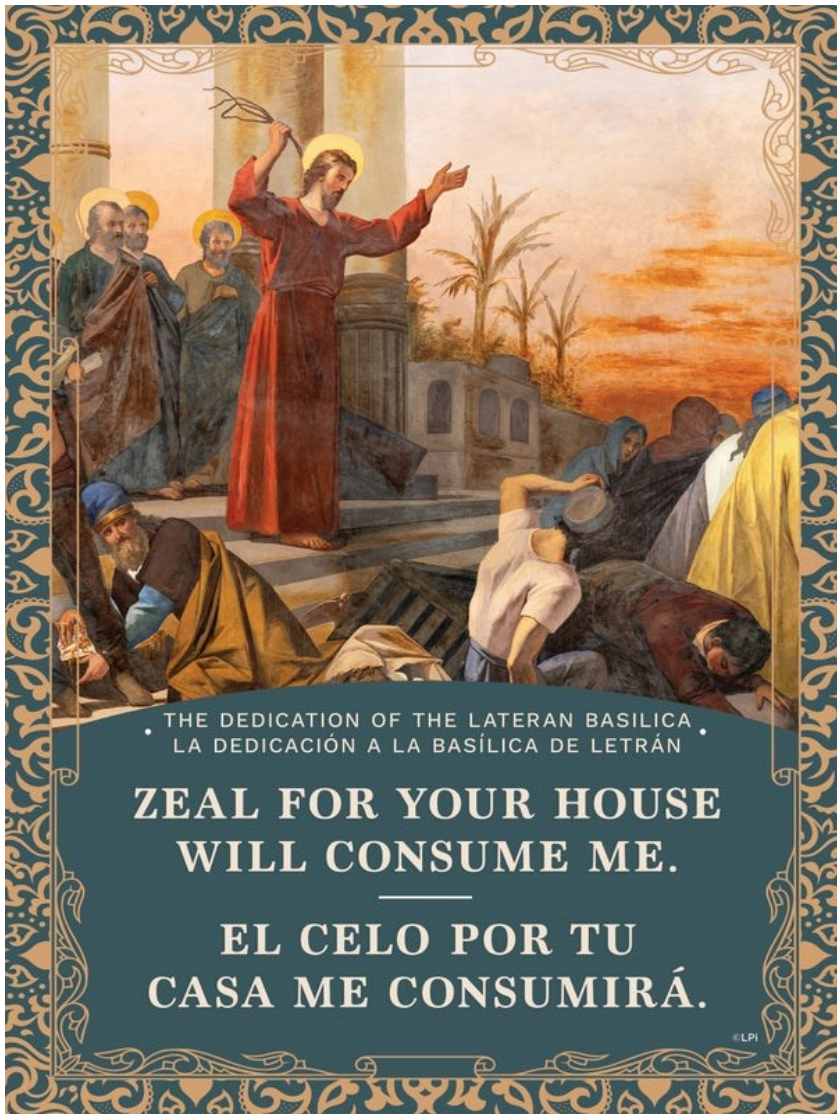

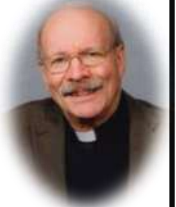

Dear Folks,

This weekend we celebrate the Feast of the Dedication of the St. John Lateran Basilica in Rome. First, a little history: what is this basilica? “To dedicate or consecrate” a place to God is a ritual that is found in every religion. To “reserve” a place to God is an act of recognizing His glory and honor. When Emperor Constantine granted full liberty to Christians in 313, Constantine himself constructed a magnificent basilica on the Caelian Hill in Rome, over the ancient Lateran Palace, which Pope Sylvester I dedicated to Christ the Savior (318 or 324). A chapel dedicated to Saint John the Baptist was built inside it which served as the baptistry. This moved Pope Sergius III to dedicate it to Saint John the Baptist as well. Lastly, Pope Lucius II also dedicated it to Saint John the Evangelist in the 12th century. Thus, the name of this Papal Basilica is the Basilica of the Most Holy Savior and of Saints John the Baptist and John the Evangelist in the Lateran. Christians consider the Basilica to be the *mother church of all churches in the world*.

Finally, why do we celebrate this special basilica? Today’s Feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica allows us to remember the journey of the people and God’s constant and faithful care. At the same time, we are reminded today that each one of us is a “house of God” in the Risen Jesus, because the Holy Spirit dwells in each one of us (cf. 1 Cor. 3:16). This awareness alone leads us to praise the Lord on the one hand, and on the other, it leads us to remember the passage, “O Lord, I am not worthy that you should enter under my roof” (Mt. 8:8), forgetting that He is already in us and that He welcomes us and loves us not as we would like to be, but as we are, here, now. These days we do not see clearly, but as in a mirror, dimly. All the present distractions keep us from seeing the Lord’s face clearly. When we learn to keep our gaze fixed on Jesus, and our friendship with Him (cf. Heb 12:1-4), our faces will shine with light that flows from a “unified” heart all our lives. Hence, this basilica is a most special “House of the Church” where the Sacred Assembly gathers in praise of God for the gift of Jesus by the power of the Holy Spirit!

Hispanic Comunidad

Queridos amigos:

Este fin de semana celebramos la fiesta de la dedicación de la basílica de San Juan de Letrán en Roma. En primer lugar, un poco de historia: ¿qué es esta basílica? «Dedicar o consagrar» un lugar a Dios es un ritual que se encuentra en todas las religiones. «Reservar» un lugar a Dios es un acto de reconocimiento de su gloria y honor. Cuando el emperador Constantino concedió plena libertad a los cristianos en el año 313, él mismo construyó una magnífica basílica en la colina del Celio, en Roma, sobre el antiguo Palacio Lateranense, que el papa Silvestre I dedicó a Cristo Salvador (318 o 324). En su interior se construyó una capilla dedicada a San Juan Bautista que servía de bautisterio. Esto movió al papa Sergio III a dedicarla también a San Juan Bautista. Por último, el papa Lucio II también la dedicó a San Juan Evangelista en el siglo XII. Así, el nombre de esta basílica papal es Basílica del Santísimo Salvador y de los Santos Juan Bautista y Juan Evangelista en Letrán. Los cristianos consideran que la basílica es la iglesia madre de todas las iglesias del mundo.



Por último, ¿por qué celebramos esta basílica tan especial? La fiesta de hoy, la Dedicación de la Basílica de Letrán, nos permite recordar el camino del pueblo y el cuidado constante y fiel de Dios. Al mismo tiempo, hoy se nos recuerda que cada uno de nosotros es una «casa de Dios» en Jesús resucitado, porque el Espíritu Santo habita en cada uno de nosotros (cf. 1 Cor 3, 16). Esta conciencia nos lleva, por un lado, a alabar al Señor y, por otro, a recordar el pasaje: «Señor, no soy digno de que entres en mi casa» (Mt 8, 8), olvidando que Él ya está en nosotros y que nos acoge y nos ama no como nos gustaría ser, sino como somos, aquí y ahora. En estos días no vemos con claridad, sino como en un espejo, de forma borrosa. Todas las distracciones actuales nos impiden ver claramente el rostro del Señor. Cuando aprendamos a mantener nuestra mirada fija en Jesús y nuestra amistad con Él (cf. Heb 12, 1-4), nuestros rostros brillarán con la luz que brota de un corazón «unificado» durante toda nuestra vida. Por lo tanto, esta basílica es una «Casa de la Iglesia» muy especial, donde la Asamblea Sagrada se reúne para alabar a Dios por el don de Jesús por el poder del Espíritu Santo.

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No conviertan en mercado la casa de mi Padre

El templo es un lugar donde la comunidad va a rezar, a alabar al Señor, a darle gracias, pero sobre todo a adorar: en el templo se adora al Señor. Y este es el punto importante. También, esto es válido para las ceremonias litúrgicas, ¿qué es más importante? Lo más importante es la adoración: toda la comunidad reunida mira al altar donde se celebra el sacrificio y adora. Pero, yo creo -

humildemente lo digo - que nosotros cristianos quizá hemos perdido un poco el sentido de la adoración y pensamos: vamos al templo, nos reunimos como hermanos - ¡es bueno, es bonito! - pero el centro está donde está Dios. Y nosotros adoramos a Dios.

¿Nuestros templos, son lugares de adoración, favorecen la adoración? ¿Nuestras celebraciones favorecen la adoración? Jesús echa a los mercaderes que habían tomado el templo por un lugar de comercio más que de adoración. (Cf. S.S. Francisco, 22 de noviembre de 2013, homilía en Santa Marta).

Reflexión

No deja de sorprendernos ver a Jesús enfurecido, sacando a los mercaderes del Templo a latigazos. Tenía que defender algo sagrado: la casa de su Padre. Es lógico que se enfade por una situación como esa. ¿Qué haríamos nosotros si entrásemos en la casa de nuestros padres y aquello se hubiera convertido en un mercado persa? Si no hiciéramos nada, ¡menudos hijos seríamos!

Lo más probable es que siguiéramos el ejemplo de Cristo. Porque Jesús amaba a su Padre infinitamente y no podía consentir aquel abuso. El amor apasionado le impulsaba a actuar de aquel modo.

Hoy sigue habiendo "mercaderes en el Templo". Sabemos que cada hombre es "templo del Espíritu Santo" y hay muchos hombres y mujeres cuyos templos están siendo profanados con todo tipo de abusos morales y físicos. Este panorama debería "quemarnos" las entrañas y suscitar en nosotros una pasión por lo que es sagrado: cada ser humano.

¡Cuántos atropellos a su dignidad! Cada aborto, cada violación, cada acto de esclavitud es una verdadera profanación.

Propósito

Nosotros, como cristianos, deberíamos salir en defensa de todos esos hermanos nuestros que sufren, pues ahí está también Cristo sufriendo. ¿Qué está en mis manos?

Diálogo con Cristo

Espíritu Santo, te pido la sabiduría y la fortaleza para saber defender a la Iglesia. Que nunca acepte la mediocridad o la indiferencia. Frecuentemente dejo que la apatía o la flojera disminuyan mis ganas de trabajar, por eso te pido que enciendas en mí el fuego de tu amor para ser un apóstol, empezando por mi propia familia.

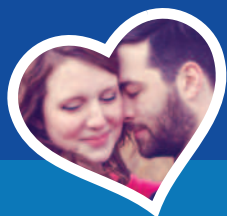
