What is Taizé Prayer?

In the south of Burgundy, France lays a small village called Taizé. This village founded over seventy years ago by Brother Roger is home to a monastic community devoted to prayer and reconciliation. The community is made up of people from all the continents and major denominations who gather together three times a day, seven days a week, throughout the year to pray (whether there are 7000 people present or only twenty).

Taizé is a form of Christian prayer in which we are invited to rest in God through the singing of psalm verses and other simple chants, alternating with periods of silent reflection. It is a time to "come away and rest for a while" through experience of the simplicity and depth of the Word of God.

Gift yourself with this hour of gentle quiet us as we seek "...the peace that goes beyond all understanding" by joining our voices, hearts and love as brothers and sisters in Christ. Please invite others from outside our community to attend with you. Folks of all beliefs and faiths are welcome.
