
And now more regarding our hymnals. **Our choice is the Gather Four hard-bound hymnal with ribbons to help us find our way to the hymns, psalms, the Order of the Mass and the Scriptures.** This is a one-time investment for many years, unlike other paperback hymnals that we would have to replace every year. **There will also be a music supplement in the pews, with music choices not in the hymnal.** No one hymnal can contain it all! We will not be placing "in memory" labels or stickers in the front of the hymnals, so that any future sale will be enhanced. Just use the analogy of trading in a car for another one!

The cost is \$11,000 for all the books we need. We will supplement at Christmas and Easter with paper worship aids which we already have for those liturgical seasons. More about the hymnals next week!

PLEASE DO NOT FORGET! The building fund for the new Roncalli Elementary and Middle School continues to grow, with almost \$14 million collected so far. Be assured that many, many groups and individuals are being contacted to help: Roncalli alumni and other generous donors who are able to make a legacy gift, that is, a once-in-a-lifetime gift to build on the foundation started by past generations who provided for us, as we now provide an opportunity for future families. Before my own family lawyer died a couple of years ago, she looked at me and asked about my giving, telling me to be careful. St. Therese of Lisieux
Feast Day: October 1st

Therese was born in 1873 to Zelie and Louis Martin, who later were known as saints. She was lively and cheerful and grew up with four older sisters, but sadness overclouded her at the age of four when her mother died. Her older sister Pauline became like a second mother to her, but when she left home to become a Carmelite nun, Therese fell terribly ill. She turned to the statue of Mary in her room and pleaded for Mary’s help. Suddenly, that statue gave her a smile full of such radiance and love that Therese was instantly cured.

Therese yearned to be a Carmelite nun, but was told she was too young. She reached out to the pope and after she begged and begged him, he allowed her to enter the convent early.

Therese’s time in the convent was ordinary. None of the sisters knew that this little nun was an extraordinary saint. Therese knew that she was like a little child and could not do great, extraordinary things on her own. So she practiced her “little way,” which meant that every little thing she did, she did for love of God. The prioress ordered Therese to write down her life in a book, which we can read today to learn all about her little way. She died a holy death from illness, offering her suffering to God with love. She died at the age of 24.

¿Qué es el sacramento de la unción de los enfermos?

El sacramento de la unción de los enfermos es un sacramento de curación, el cual es un regalo de Dios que ayuda a sanar y purificar el espíritu de quien lo recibe. A través de él, se pide al Señor, la salud del cuerpo, del alma y del espíritu del cristiano que pasa por una grave enfermedad o vejez avanzada. Asimismo, al recibir la unción bien dispuesto y en gracia, si es la voluntad de Dios, puede obtenerse, incluso, la curación o la salud que necesita el enfermo.

La Iglesia lo define así: "La gracia primera de este sacramento es una gracia de consuelo, de paz y de ánimo para vencer las dificultades propias del estado de enfermedad grave o de la fragilidad de la vejez. [...] Esta asistencia del Señor, por la fuerza de su Espíritu, quiere conducir al enfermo a la curación del alma, pero también a la del cuerpo, si tal es la voluntad de Dios" (CEC 1520).

Este sacramento sólo puede ser administrado por el obispo o el sacerdote, quien ungirá con aceite consagrado en la frente y en las palmas de las manos, pronunciando a su vez las palabras: "Por esta santa unción, y por su bondadosa misericordia, te ayude el Señor con la gracia del Espíritu Santo, para que, libre de tus pecados, te conceda la salvación y te conforme en tu enfermedad" (Sacram Unctionem Infirmorum; cf CIC, can. 847, §1).

Ahora bien, no se debe pensar que este signo sacramental está reservado solamente para quienes estén cerca de la muerte, sino que también pueden recibirla aquellos que sean conscientes y que, por voluntad propia, consideren necesario recibirla en caso de grave enfermedad. De tal modo que, si un fiel está en peligro de muerte, está sufriendo una grave enfermedad, pasa por avanzad edad o recibirá una operación delicada, puede solicitar que se le administre dicho sacramento.

No hay un límite de veces para poder recibir este sacramento, sino que

puede recibirse las veces que sean necesarias, siempre y cuando se encuentre en peligro de muerte, pase por momentos de debilidad en la salud, o bien, las personas con edad avanzada. Así que resulta conveniente no esperar hasta el último momento para poder recibir este sacramento, ya que su fin no es alcanzar milagros, sino preparar espiritualmente a quien lo recibe. Además, es importante decir que este sacramento, como todo otro sacramento, es de vivos; es decir, que debe recibirse en estado de gracia. Aunque la Iglesia establece que, si el enfermo no pudo recibir el sacramento de la penitencia y, por alguna razón se encuentra inconsciente, se le podrá dar la absolución de sus pecados bajo condición y, luego, se le puede administración el sacramento de la unción, también bajo condición.

Si un enfermo de gravedad falleció sin recibir este sacramento, la Iglesia recomienda, aun así, administrarlo durante las primeras horas en que ha fallecido. Así lo establece el Código de Derecho Canónico: "En la duda sobre si el enfermo ha alcanzado el uso de razón, sufre una enfermedad grave o ha fallecido ya, adminístrele este sacramento" (1005 CIC).

Es importante que, como creyentes en Cristo, procuremos prepararnos para el momento de nuestra muerte, ya que no sabemos cuándo llegará. Por lo tanto, es recomendable que con frecuencia acudamos a los sacramentos que alimentan y fortalecen nuestro espíritu como son la comunión y la penitencia.



Misa dominical con el Sacramento de unción de los Enfermos



Este Sacramento, es un acto litúrgico comunitario realizado en la iglesia, por el cual el sacerdote signa con oleo sagrado a una persona bautizada, enferma (de cuerpo, alma y /o espíritu) o en una edad avanzada (a partir de los 65 años) o en peligro de muerte. Con esta acción, se significa que le es concedida al enfermo o al anciano una gracia especial eficaz para fortalecerlo o reconfortarlo en su enfermedad, y prepararlo para el encuentro con Dios
