

DIRECTIONS FOR APPLYING TO FLEXIBLE TUITION PROGRAM

The Roncalli Catholic Schools Flexible Tuition Program (FTP) aims to help families afford a Catholic education for their children. Flexible tuition means that the Catholic schools examine your family's financial circumstances in order to determine what you can afford to contribute towards the cost of the education of your children. Parents/guardians need to contact the Catholic school to discuss your family's financial situation in order to discover if your family qualifies for the flexible tuition program (click above on this website for a list of Catholic Schools in the Newton area, their websites, and directions to them).

If parents/guardians do not qualify for or cannot currently obtain the Wisconsin Parental Choice Program (WPCP, see the description of the program on this website), they may be candidates for the FTP.

Tuition assistance is available. During the Roncalli High School 2020-2021 school year, only 24% of students paid the full tuition costs, 35% paid what families could afford to pay through the flexible tuition program, and 41% had their tuition paid for by the WPCP. All Catholic elementary schools in our area have some form of flexible tuition so that eligible parents/guardians do not pay the full tuition for their children.

How do parents/guardians apply for flexible tuition for their children? Parents/guardians submit a secure, online application through the FACTS Tuition Management website [<https://factsmgt.com>], and FACTS calculates a level of tuition that works for their circumstances and is within their budget. Then FACTS uses funds provided by generous donors to reduce their payments to an affordable amount, and provides other options for paying tuition annually, semi-annually, or monthly. There is some form of tuition reduction for almost every eligible parent/guardian who asks for it.
